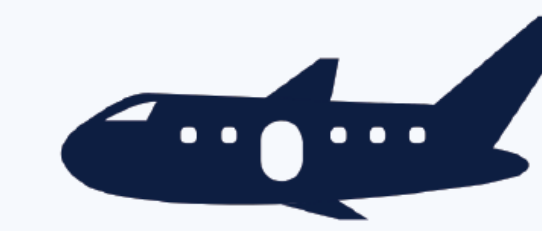
- No single-use food containers are used
- Plastic bottles are limited
- No additional carpet is installed besides stage carpet



- The venue is Earth Check Gold certified



- Living plants are preferred to cut flowers for decoration



- Offsetting of all Forum staff air travel emissions



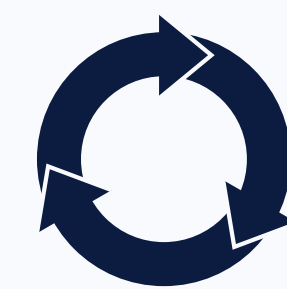
- No diesel power generator is used
- Temperature is set between 21°C and 25°C to optimize energy consumption



- Menus consist of 70% vegetarian options and 90% ingredients sourced in India



- Full carbon footprint assessment of the summit



- Furniture is rented or reused from past events and saved for future events



- Organic waste is used for biogas production



- Decorative elements will be donated to a local association after the summit.
- Fabric will be used to create bags and household equipment; plastic will be melted to create pavement; and wood will be used for construction or recycled.
